

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This memorandum records and formalises an exchange agreement made between our two schools in 2022.

We have agreed to set up a reciprocal exchange programme whereby students in one school in any one year can exchange places with an equivalent number of students in the partner school.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES OF SCORA

SCORA schools are committed to ensuring that:

- the principals themselves are in charge of the project
- there is an agreement of all teachers that the school community shares the values and goals of SCORA and actively brings them to life in everyday school life
- there is a team of teachers responsible for the project
- both partner schools set their focus depending on the school profile
- there is a willingness to travel to Israel or Germany and receive Israeli or German guests (teams of teachers, students)
- the school community works actively to develop a diversity-friendly school culture and does not tolerate any form of discrimination
- the teachers use multi-method and multi-media approaches to this topic (cognitive, reflective, biographical, creative, digital, etc.) and for their exchange
- they influence the civil society of their area with the aims and values of the project through actions or the like.

The purpose of the exchange and the educational and cultural outcomes of the programme is to experience the host culture. It is intended that students attend class in the host school and join in extra-curricular activities where possible.

Both schools guarantee that good pastoral care will be taken of the students involved and that they will be given support while on the exchange, both by the host families and school staff.

Overall responsibility for the exchange programmes lies with the principals and boards of the two schools. The programme includes a trial period of six months and may be terminated after five years.
